## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. Entry is open to any person of any age.
2. **There is no entry fee to participate for schools' section but \$5.00 entry fee for open (17+) category**
3. Entries and their decorated cake must be the bona fide work of the entrant.
4. All decorations must be handmade by the entrant (excludes ribbon and exceptions). Moulds may be used. Novelty shaped cake tins are permitted.
5. Whilst reasonable care will be taken of competition items, organisers or their delegates cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage that may occur.
6. Judging is undertaken by independent and experienced pastry chefs and chefs.

**CATEGORIES:** There are three (3) sections within the competition –

1. Primary school chocolate decorated cup cake (present one 1 cup cake)
2. Chocolate Themed birthday Cake Competition - High School/College section
3. Open section for people aged 17 and over chocolate themed celebration cake 2 tiers, cakes will be cut and taste tested in this category.

The chocolate birthday themed cake section can be any type of birthday cake as long as it is decorated in a chocolate theme.

**VENUE:** The Lucas Hotel Sampling room over the bridge, 46 Gilbert Street Latrobe.

**DELIVERY OF ENTRIES:** Multiple entries are accepted. All entries must be delivered to the venue between 9.00am - 10.00am on Sunday, 14 August 2022. Entries that arrive outside this time will be accepted but not judged. (within reason, we want all competitors to get their entries in)

**JUDGING:** All entries will be judged on Sunday, 14 August at 2.30pm.

Cakes will be judged on chocolate inspiration, originality and birthday cake/cup cake/chocolate celebration themed cake designs. Open 17+ section 2 tier cakes will be cut and tasted for judged to score on taste and texture. A school name card will be provided on entry. If competitors wish to also submit overview/details of their submission organizers as that you keep this to one A4 sized document to allow room for other displays, this can be laminated or in a plastic pouch.

**PUBLIC EXHIBITION:** The venue will be open to the public from 10.00am until 3.00pm during Chocolate Winterfest, Latrobe.

**PEOPLE'S CHOICE AWARD:** Patrons are invited to vote for their favourite overall chocolate cake in the "People's Choice Award" from 10.00am until 2.30pm. 3 boxes provided – primary school, high school/college and open section.

**PRIZES** in all sections will be presented at 3.00pm on Sunday, 14 August 2022, if you are not in attendance, we will organise your prize to be dropped off to your location the following week.

**COLLECTION OF EXHIBITS:** All exhibits will be available for collection immediately following the announcement of awards around 3.30pm on Sunday, 14 August 2022. Any un-collected entries will be disposed of after 4.00 pm unless otherwise pre-arranged with event organisers.
