# conditions of entry

1. The use of chocolate is core to this competition.
2. Entry is open to any person of any age.
3. There is no entry fee to participate in the student section.
4. A \$5.00 entry fee applies for the Open section.
5. Entries and their decorated cake must be the bona fide work of the entrant.
6. All decorations must be handmade by the entrant (excludes ribbon and exceptions). Moulds may be used. Novelty-shaped cake tins are permitted.
7. Multiple entries are accepted.
8. Whilst reasonable care will be taken of competition items, organisers or their delegates cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage that may occur.
9. Judging is undertaken by independent and experienced pastry chefs and chefs.

## CATEGORIES:

There are five (5) sections within the competition -

1. Primary school **chocolate** decorated cupcake.  
One cupcake is to be presented in any decoration theme as long as chocolate is used and evident.
2. Grades 7/8 High school section Christmas-themed cake  
Size - round and no larger than 30cm, one layer/level only, must incorporate and show **chocolate**.
3. Grades 9/10 High school section Animal-themed cake  
Size - round no larger than 30cm, one layer/level only, must incorporate and show **chocolate**.
4. College section Grade 11/12 - **Chocolate** themed Birthday cake.  
No size restriction. The birthday cake can be for a boy or girl of any age. Chocolate must be evident.
5. Open section for entrants aged 17+. **Chocolate**-themed Wedding cake  
Must be two (2) tiers. Chocolate must be evident. Cakes will be cut and taste tested in this category.

## VENUE:

Australian Axemans Hall of Fame, Bells Parade, Latrobe

## DELIVERY OF ENTRIES:

All entries must be delivered to the venue between 9.30am until 10.30am on Sunday, 13<sup>th</sup> August 2023.

Entries that arrive outside this time will be accepted but not judged.

Within reason, we want all competitors to get their entries in.



## JUDGING:

All entries will be judged on Sunday, 13<sup>th</sup> August at 2.00pm.

Cakes will be judged on chocolate inspiration, originality and against the relevant theme.

Open section must be two tiered and will be cut and tasted for judged to score on taste and texture.

A school name card will be provided on entry.

Competitors may wish to submit an overview of their entry. This must be limited to one A4 page to allow room for other displays. It should be laminated or provided in a plastic pouch.

## PUBLIC EXHIBITION:

The venue will be open to the public during Chocolate Winterfest, Latrobe from 10.30am until 3.00pm.

## PEOPLE'S CHOICE AWARD:

A box will be provided at the venue for the public to vote for their favourite cakes in each section between 10.30 am until 2.30 pm.

There will also be a randomly drawn public prize, so tell all your friends and family and get them voting.
